#### **Production Engineer | Quantum Design, San Diego, CA | May 2002 - December 2005 (3 years 8 months)**

- Carried out investigations of the magnetic and superconducting properties of Ruthenium compounds doped with varying concentrations of Iridium utilizing X-ray diffraction (XRD) analysis, measurements of the temperature dependence of electrical resistivity, and of the ac and dc magnetic susceptibilities.
- Collaborated with R&D, Chief Engineers, Production and Machine Shop to troubleshoot hardware issues, help with the development of new system options, build prototypes and acted as a liaison between Company and vendors to establish and maintain strategic business relationships.
- Managed a line of product called MPMS (Magnetic Property Measurement System) functioning at cryogenic temperatures, that utilizes SQUID Magnetometry, liquid Helium and liquid Nitrogen to measure the magnetic properties of laboratory samples.
